Planning Basics – Dory Zinkand

Poetry – Christine Perrin

Do you want to teach more poetry, but don't know where to start? Gain confidence and experience as Christine Perrin, poet, teacher and author of *The Art of Poetry*, a new curriculum resource from Classical Academic Press, shows us how to include poetry in the curriculum.

Progymnasmata – Jim Selby

Jim Selby will be with us for two days to train us to use his *Classical Composition*, a program based upon the Progymnasmata developed in the third century by Aphthonius to train his students in rhetoric. The program is used in grades four through twelve for composition and rhetoric.

Friday, August 14, 2009

Incorporating the Arts across the Curriculum – Steve Turley & Dory Zinkand

Steve Turley will set the tone by discussing a Christian philosophy of the arts and the place of the arts in a classical and Christian curriculum. Then Dory Zinkand will lead us through some sample interpretive lessons that integrate art with other disciplines.

The Seven Laws of Teaching – Don Post & Dory Zinkand

This will be a discussion of John Milton Gregory's *The Seven Laws of Teaching*, a classic work that sets out principles of pedagogy used in all ACCS schools. Participants should read an unabridged version of this book prior to the workshop.

Assessment and Grading across the Trivium - Don Post & Dory Zinkand

How do we effectively measure achievement at the grammar, dialectic and rhetoric levels? How should assignments and class discussions differ at these levels? Participants will discuss these questions and practice writing assignments appropriate to the three levels of the Trivium.
